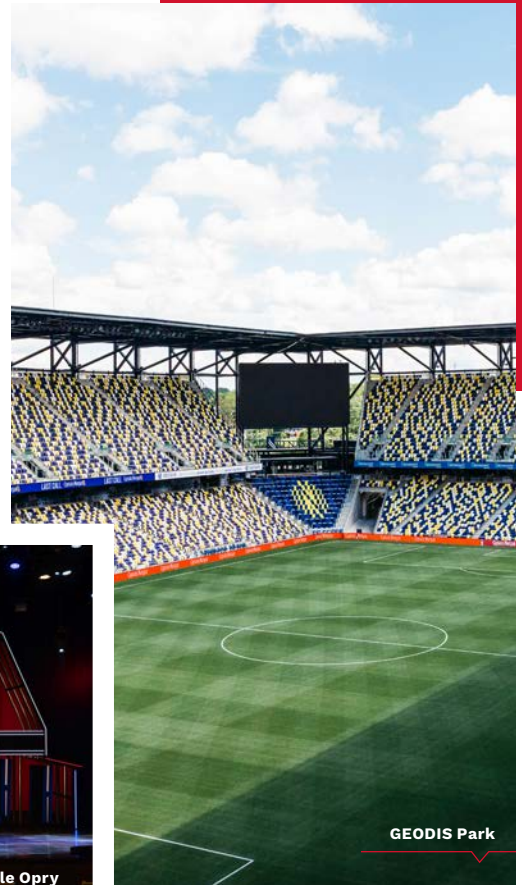

DAY ONE

Day

Then visit the **Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum** for a self-guided tour.

Day

After the excitement of touring and performing, your group will enjoy a delicious lunch at **Nashville Underground** before heading backstage at the "Mother Church of Country Music," the **Ryman Auditorium**.

Afternoon

Learn about Nashville's pivotal role in the Modern Civil Rights Movement with a visit to **Witness Walls**. This public artwork was inspired by the events and Nashvillians who took action to inspire change over a half century ago.

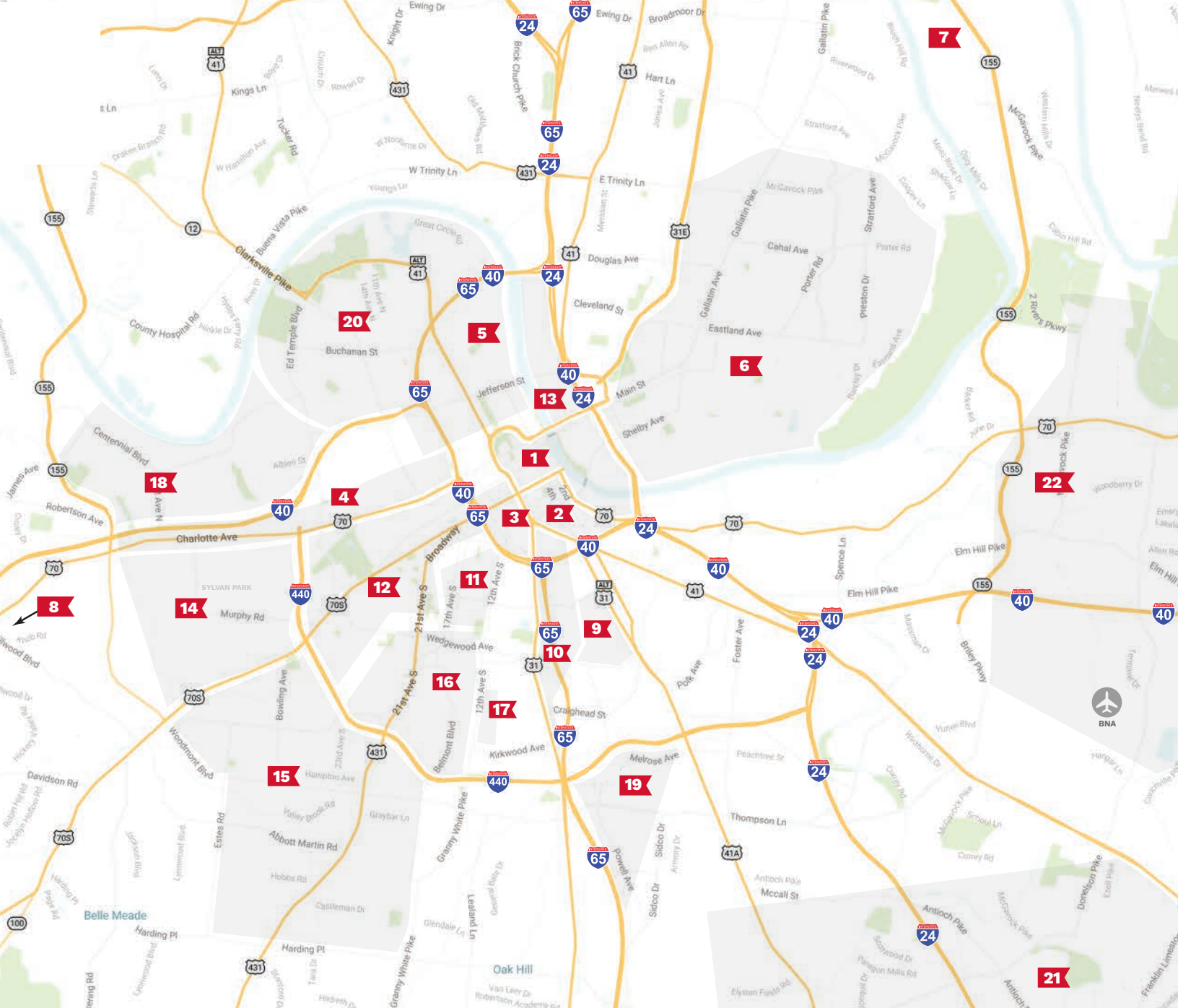
Next, experience the **Musicians Hall of Fame & Museum**, the one and only museum in the world that honors the talented musicians who actually played on the greatest recordings of all time.
